League Registration Process 2020/21

1. Get consent for players to sign if their parents. Consent can be done in the form of the player form attached. These forms need to be stored correctly by the clubs (within GDPR guidelines) and available for spot check at any point.
2. Once consent has been acquired, use the Whole Game System to register your player. If the player is new, you must email proof of age to the registrar. This data will be deleted upon completion of checks. 3. Await for the registrars to approve registrations. Once this has been done, a data transfer will occur between the WGS and helpwithit. This will happen at a set time every day up until August 31st and then every Sunday thereafter in accordance with DR7f(2). All the transfer of data will happen around 7pm each day. This will generate the league ID cards on helpwithit.
4. Print off and cut out the league ID cards and send them to your registrar with a self-addressed envelope. These will be processed and posted back. (Registrars will not do an at the door service).
