## FIFA COMPETITION

We are going to host a league FIFA competition. This will be set out as follows. We will have a competition for the Xbox One and a competition for the Playstation 4. Each age group will have it's own individual competition within these two categories.

Each team within a club will only be allowed 1 entry per competition. For example, SDJSFL FC at U7's would be allowed 1 entry into the Xbox competition and 1 into the Playstation. Entry will cost £20 per individual competition.

The entry fee will then be split as follows per each individual competition:  
25% - League Hardship Fun  
25% - A charity of the winners choice  
50% - Prizes for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th as well as their respective teams.

The competition will start in late August/early september (date to be released nearer to the time).
